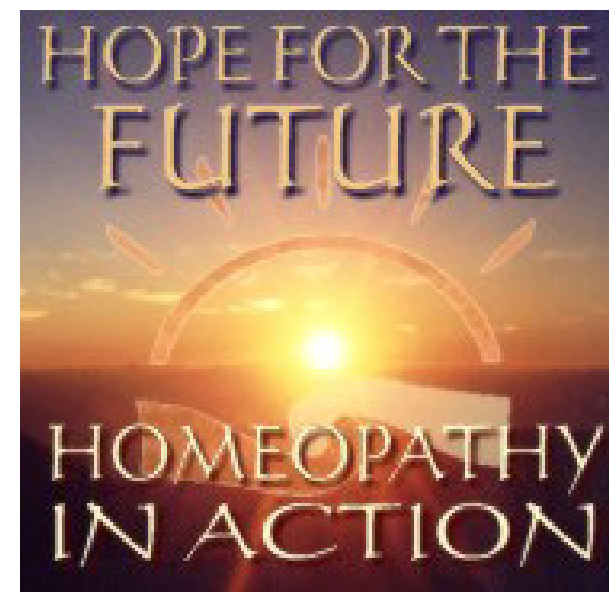

- **Vaccinations:** Are They Safe? Are They Effective? Are They Necessary?
